Loose change in the offering plate has been designated for the LWML Mites.

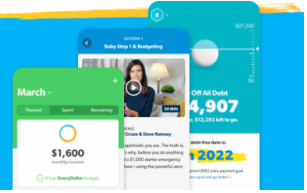
