CHURCH WIRING PROJECT UPDATE


Progress continues on the removing of old wiring and the installation of new in the church. Electrician Jay Deadmond and his assistant are in charge of the project. As of this date all of the 90 year old wiring in the attic has been replaced. Now each light in the balcony that hangs from the wood ceiling has new wiring. In addition, the wall lights at the front of the church on the north and south side has had the old wiring removed and replaced with new. The next step is to rewire the lights that are above the pews on the lower level. This task will be completed by the removal of sections of flooring in the balcony. This will allow replacing the old wiring with new. In addition, there are three (3) wall outlets that are part of the original wiring. One in the Sacristy, and one on the north and south walls near the front of the church. The congregation will be responsible for opening the floor in the balcony, by carefully removing pieces of the tongue and groove floor so the electrician can get to the old wiring. If you are interested in being part of this project, please inform Eric Grobengieser as soon as possible.
